ESHG-Y Committee Members

The committee defines the aims of the ESHG-Y in collaboration with the ESHG Board for the period of the mandate.

Elections for the ESHG-Y Committee are held annually.

The members of the Committee must also be members of the ESHG.

The Committee is composed of 7 members elected for a period of 2 years.

The members of the Committee represent at least 4 different European countries.

ESHG annual meeting

The candidate has to send via email a motivation letter and a 1 page CV to the ESHG-Y Committee at least 60 days before the ESHG annual meeting

for evaluation.

The candidate names will be shared on the ESHG-Y mailing list and social media at least 50 days before the ESHG annual meeting.

The voting process should start at least 30 days before the ESHG annual meeting.

The voting should end 20 days before the ESHG annual meeting.
